Procedure for Certifying Clears

This Applies World-Wide
All Offices and Auditors

Clears are tested by several departments. In only one Dept does all this data assemble. And only that one unit can pronounce a clear clear.

Testing Department gives test. Testing should not tell PC anything which would lead PC to think he has been passed for clear.

Dir/Pr gives an E-Meter test and review of written tests but cannot finally inform PC he is clear. The most he can say is that it seems so but final declaration of clear is reserved to the HCO Board of Review.

When all papers and data are assembled at HCO Board of Review, this unit then reviews the entire picture. HCO Board of Review can call for a retest at its own discretion after a lapse of time.

Only when HCO Board of Review is completely satisfied does it then issue a clear bracelet.

The issuance of the bracelet is the first time the recipient is informed finally that he is clear.

HCO Board of Review should refer cases about which it can't decide to LRH for personal review.

This Bulletin is retroactive to the first person cleared by modern Scientology.
