Command words but not as a whole phrase are cleared often(every 3 brackets) and the pc is asked for his <u>opimión</u> <u>obly</u> of the word "help" and the item. His answer is not challanged.

Only ARC breaks can hide rock again after found - clear them well. CLEAR ALSO environmental ARC breaks on the rock between sessions.
