Source Terminals Assessment

This assessment is for use only on Staff Theta Clearing Courses WW and by Staff Co-Auditors. It is not for use on HGC preclears unless the PC is a staff member.

A source terminal is a substitute for a Thetan, a Mind, a Body or the Physical Universe. In processing we can run these source terminals as a gradient scale until we have the PC in good enough shape to run "a Thetan".

The source terminals we want to process are the ones to which the PC assigns creation, but at the same time is destroying. This is a terminal which is outflowing (producing a comm-lag) and being inflowed upon (producing an automaticity). Between this outflow and inflow we get a ridge.

We do an assessment by shipping a cycle of action (create, survive, destroy) back to the terminal which is a reactive dependence on a creation now unknown.

Using the four universes of Thetan, Mind, Body, and Physical Universe, on each one find the terminal that creates by finding what the PC is destroying.

All source terminals located, that need to be run will produce a changed needle behavior on an E-meter and you select the one which produces the greatest needle reaction.

Run "What part of a _____ (selected source terminal) would you be willing to create?" and we're off on the road to O.T.
