An Auditing Win

Here is an extract from a letter recently received from a field auditor, which will be of general interest:

"Recently finished 75 hour intensive with 69 year old woman; 25 hours CCH1, 50 hours CCH3 (whew). She arrived partially insane and in very, very poor physical condition; her only communication was that she wanted to die. My own assessment was that she was actually dying. For thirty hours we waded through vomit and very frequent bowel movements over which there seemed to be little control. Then moans, then shrieks, then fits of throwing herself on the floor. A lot of the time communication consisted of 'This is doing me no good; how does this help; poor, poor, Michael how you do try' etc. etc. etc." There were occasions when, after a session, I felt like weeping; and there was one occasion when I very nigh blew my top. But we continued; she must have been game, because she turned up every day without missing, coming many miles through fog, rain and bitter cold."

"Then one day: victory (or at least the first signs of it,) - whilst doing book mimicry she took the book and beat me over the head with it. After that, there were tough patches, but it was plain sailing, she just continued to come up and up. She finished the Intensive, brisk, cheerful and with plans that stretched six months into the future.

I think I'll have the CCH's run on me now!!"
