## A GOOD SESSION

An American auditor sent Ron the following letter describing an interesting session:

"Your April 7, bulletin is really fine. Thanks very much indeed.

My auditor did me a big favour last night in line with that bulletin. I was feeling lousy as heck and my body was feeling rough. I sat there boo - hoo'ing and not knowing what to do. (pore victim) We had I hour available for a session and the auditor ran me on "You make that body sit in that chair". I was perfectly happy to run it, and while it isn't yet flat (ran it about 40 minutes). it sure is a fine process and I felt better by session end - and today I am feeling better generally, and am a hot advocate for this particular process - you know how it is when a pc gets a win, he's a little inclined to feel that "everybody should be run on this process!"

It was sort of a new experience. I discovered that my body hadn't been accustomed to taking orders from me, at all. It felt like it wanted to get up and leave. After a bit, something occurred which half scared me out of my wits! A big black thing which I described as an "evil entity" loomed up at me from the stomach area - I quickly turned my head (I didn't want to confront it), but finally looked at it. "It" was angry at me - "how dare you start ordering this body around!! This is my domain! You are intruding, you trespasser!" etc. It was fuming mad! (I have had no personal subjective reality till now on what we call the Genetic Entity, and I believe this is what I've come across here. Hope to find out more about this at next session). I also had pictures of bodies sitting in chairs tied with ropes, trying to get away, etc.

Yes sir, this is definitely a fine process and I never thought I would be run on it. I thought it was for "other people"! It is getting more and more real to me that what you say is definitely correct - the goal of auditing is not finding out what is wrong with the pc and processing that (Q & A with bank), but to find something the pc can do and improve that.

Yes, I had a win in processing, and on a process I never suspected I needed to be run on!"
