New Experimental Havingness Processes:

- "Look around here and find something you don't have to make duplicate you  
Feel that (indicated object)."
- "How could you have that (indicate room object)?"
- "How could that (indicated room object) make somebody guilty?"
- "Notice that (room object) How long are you absolutely sure it will be there?"
- "What problem could that wall be?"

Confront Processes:

- "What unworkable situation could you confront?"
- "What unworkable situation would you rather not confront?"

- "What sexual activity could you confront?"
- "What sexual activity would you rather not confront?"

- "What sound (or other perception) could you confront?"
