MISSED VITHOLDS, ASKING ABOUT.

Since a pc can give a motivator response to the question, "Have I missed a withold on you?" and since a pc's case can be worsened by permitting the pc to get off motivators rather than overts, the following becomes a <u>must</u> in asking for Missed Witholds:

"What have you done that I haven't found out about?"

Use "done", not "missed a withold" in all missed w/h questions.

The prior confusion aspect will be found to operate also if this is followed and the missed withold will blow.

In short use <u>done</u> not "missed withold" in rudiments and middle rudiments questions and stress doingness rather than witholdingness.
