CHECKING NEEDLE IN RUDIMENTS CHECKS

The following types of needle characteristic are defined and published here as a guide to all rudiment checkers.

CLEAN NEEDLE:

Responsive to instant reads only.

MEDIUM CLEAN:

Offers many prior and latent reads, but reads instantly when a question is asked.

MEDIUM DIRTY:

Agitated throughout check but with periods of no agitation when a read can be obtained easily. Reacts to checkers voice.

DIRTY NEEDLE:

Agitated throughout check, making reading difficult. Pc's attention obviously dispersed.
