The ARC Straightwire process now used in training is the old - Recall a time.....

This is hereby changed for the follwing reason:

Students and co-audit pc's go out of session when permitted to answer only "yes" to the command, as the two-way comm is deleted and the definition of "In Session" is violated.

With the advent of of Repetitive Rudiments the student should be otherwise (and better) trained on a repetitve process.

A second question is thereby added to the ARC process and any co-audit process that can be merely answered "yes".

The new process:

RECALL A COMMUNICATION. WHAT WAS IT?

RECALL SOMETHING REAL. WHAT WAS IT?

RECALL AN EMOTION. WHAT WAS IT?

Do not use the older versions or any process that can be answered only with "yes" without adding the second question.
