<u>Urgent - Important - LX 3</u> <u>Handling of</u>

Since LX 3 is a list which has been originally issued with the purpose of handling "Out of Valence", item "h" of GF 40, and since LX 3 covers Attitudes, the Class VIII Auditor when handling LX 3 items, should and must separate the 3 flows very precisely, as a cross of flows can create a confusion within pc's reality of the 3 flows of the Physical Universe.

Another point, very important one, that a Class VIII must never forget, while handling LX 3, is that he is handling the 3 aspects of an item from LX 3, which could have caused an individual to change valence.

So the actual handling of an LX 3 item would be as follows:

First: Recall Steps

- 1."Recell taking the attitude of IX 3 item ."
- 2. "Recall causing another to take the attitude of LX 3 item ."
- 3."Recall another causing another or others to take the attitude of LX 3 item ."

Second part: Engram Chains (Std R3R)

- Flow No. 1: "Locate an incident that could have caused you to take the attitude of IX 3 item ."
- Flow No. 2: "Locate an incident of you causing another to take the attitude of LY 3 item ."
- Flow No. 3: "Locate en incident of another causing another or others to take the attitude of <a href="Maintain." Of course after ABCD and the check for E/S, you'd check for an <u>earlier similar</u> incident as you are dealing with Scientology Reviews, but not Dianetic Somatic Chains.

LX 3 is handled thoroughly, which means you would perform the above actions on each item of LX 3 that reads twice or more. You would of course start by the item assessed out and continue on down to the next best reading item etc...

Do not forget that LY lists serve to isolate reasons a being is charged up to such an extent that he goes out of valence. You assess these lists (LX 3- LX 2-LX 1) on the Preclear's own definition. You don't look up what assessed out, except when the preclear doesn't understand the item on the list, in which case you would clear the misunderstook AND REASSESS as the misunderstook will cook the list.

The end phenomena of the handling and use of LX lists is a Valence shift; you end off when the pc has a marked change in Valence.
