GF to F/N

When a C/S instructs an Auditor to start a session with a GF to F/N, he means just that.

95% of the cases F/N very easily on 5a of the GF which is session ARC Breaks.

Very rarely, a pc does not F/N easily while being run on a GF because of high TA or some other hang up, well, that DOES NOT mean that it is impossible to get an F/N on that pc.

You continue running your GF until you get the F/N, even if you have to do the GF all over again, if by the time you have gone thru the whole of the GF and the pc or pre-OT has not F/Ned yet.

The same thing applies to Prepchecks. Each prepcheck is run to F/N; if by the time you have used all the 18 Prepcheck buttons on an item, and you haven't got your F/N yet, all you need to do is continue prepchecking the item, by re-starting from "suppressed" etc....

Somewhere along the line, the item will F/N.

So, if this data was not known to you as yet, here is a chance for you to have it.

Never, let drop a cycle without its end phenomena.

GFs and prepchecks when instructed by a C/S are run to F/N, even if you have to restart the whole cycle all over again.

Failing to follow the above is a break of the Auditor's Code, Clause No. 12.

It's very easy. Standard Tech is Simple. It's just a matter of sharp, crisp and precise handling and duplicating of Technology.
