NEGATIVE BLOWDOWNS

(Adds to C/S Series No.1 HCOB 24 May '70
Auditors Rights section on Unreading Items.)

A Negative Blowdown is defined as that movement of the T/A which takes it into the negative area of the Tone Arm dial (below 2.0).

A subject or item which when called off gives a Negative Blowdown (i.e. 2.0 - 1.8) indicates that the po is in an overwhelm on that subject and it MUST NOT BE RUN.

One would not try to run an item that sent the T/A high, would one?

Below 2.0 it reverses, so that what you call a Blow Down is now leading you away from the ideal (2.0 - 3.0) just in the same way as a T/A rising above 3.0 is.

So class items which give Negative Blowdowns as Unreading Items and leave them strictly alone.
