AUDITING CS-1

1. Give PC R-Factor that you are going to do an Auditing CS-1 to familiarize him with auditing procedure and any basic data that may require clarification.

NOTE: Some PC's who have been trained or audited previously may protest that they know the terms and procedure. Acknowledge with excellent TRs and without invalidation or evaluation and tell them that the CS is intended to make auditing more effective for all PC's. If the Auditor uses excellent TRs and good R-Factor, no ARC Breaks should ever occur and PC will have tremendous wins.

2. Cover by exact definition all terms used. Use HCO B 23 April 69, "Dianetics, Basic Definitions"; HCO B 11 Dec 69, "Dianetic Illustrations"; the Scientology Dictionary; any Scientology Book Glossary or Glossary Sheet and a Standard Dictionary. This is done with PC on the meter. The needle will Float on some or all of the words.

Words to be defined:

Auditor	Charge
Preclear	By Passed Charge

Do not settle for glit or perfect answers that do not show understanding. On the other hand, do not overrun or put duress on the PC.

4. Go through the following Axioms with the PC. Have him read the Axiom and look up any words he does not understand. Have the PC tell you what the Axioms mean. If the needle floats on one, go onto the next. One or all may F/N.

Scientology Axioms:

1, 2, 3, 11, 30, 32, 38, 51

Dianetic Axioms:

90 through 98

125

180 through 187.

5. Go through HCO B 11 Dec 69, "Dianetic Illustrations" with the PC off the meter. Have a very substantial Demo Kit with lots of pieces or have clay for the PC to demonstrate the following:

Lock
Secondary
Engram

Have him show how the picture erases.

6. With the PC on the meter again, have him mock up a picture of something simple like a cat and describe it to you. If he says he can't, get him to suppose he is mocking up a picture and describe it to you - and get him to do it anyway.

7. Give the PC the R-Factor that you are going to do TRs. (Training Routines.)

8. Go through HCO b 17 April '61 (revised 5 Jan 71) "Training Drills Modernized" with the PC, and have him read aloud each TR before you do it. Really clear the purpose of each TR before doing it. Do each TR O to IV this way.

NOTE: DO NOT DO ANY BULLBAITING ON TR O OR ON ANY TR. DO NOT USE "FLUNK". Clear the purpose of the TR, give the PC a start. Do the TR with the PC so that he understands. Handle any queries or doubts. Run to a flat point where PC feels good about it. His needle will probably float. Indicate the F/N if there is one, say "that's it" and go on to the next TR.

Very little time is required for each TR. Only run to a flat point or F/N. Do not grind on and on. Only a few minutes on each should be enough so he knows what is required of him as a PC. Leave each TR with a win.

9. Ask the PC what a comm cycle is. Have him put down the cans and demonstrate it. Have him pick up the cans again and ask him questions like: "Have you eaten Dinner?" (or breakfast or lunch) - and when he replies ask "What did you do when I asked you that question?" Then tell him to ask you a similar sort of question. Answer him and be sure he acknowledges you. Really establish your comm cycle with the preclear.

10. For all PC's who are going to be run on Dianetics for the first time or are about to have an Exteriorization Intensive, go through each step of R3R using HCO B 6 May 69, "Routine 3-R Revised. Engram Running by Chains."

With the pc, go through each step, 1 to 9, A to D, solid and erasing, and earlier using fruit or vegetables as the items, for dates and duration. E.g. for step 1), Locate an incident containing apples". For step 2 say, "In answer to 'what is the date of the incident?' give me an example using fruit for time," and have PC say "2 oranges" or some other fruit.

On the going, earlier step ask, "Is there an earlier incident containing apples?"

After each step ask the pc "What did you do?" so that he gets the idea of how R3R is run. Don't overdo this step, but ensure that the PC understands what is required of him at each step.

NOTE: Step 10 is added only where R3R is going to be run, including the Exteriorization Intensive.

CONCLUSION

In doing an Auditing CS-1, the auditor would pick up any disagreements or misunderstands and clear them with excellent TRs and R-Factor.

This CS-1 should not take more than a couple of hours and rarely more than four. It can usually be completed in one session. If it is done in more than one, the session should be ended off at the end of a step or completion of a word or demo - never in the middle.

This CS-1 will result in huge wins for any PC whether new or previously audited, and even the newest PC should be able to be audited like a well trained veteran PC.
