2. Is there any word on this list you didn't understand? Clear it with Dictionary. Auditor also notes meaning for himself. Have unknown words in definition also cleared. Have pc use it in sentences he makes up.

3. In the subject of _____ (one that read in No. 1 above) what word has been misunderstood? Clear it with Dictionary. Auditor also understands meaning for himself. Have unknown words in definition also cleared. Do not have him use it in sentences. If no F/N go to 4.

4. Is there an earlier word in (subject being handled) _____ you did not understand? If so, clear it with dictionary. Auditor also understands meaning.

5. Repeat 4 until pc runs out of answers and if still no F/N ask: Is there an earlier similar subject to (subject being done in 3 above) _____? When pc gives it: Is there a misunderstood word in that subject? If so clear it, auditor also understands it. Do 4 repeatedly until pc runs out of words. Then do 5 again if necessary. But there should have been an F/N by now.
