5. Is there an earlier word in (subject being handled) you did not understand? If so, clear it with dictionary. Auditor also understands meaning.
6. Repeat 5 until pc runs out of answers and if still no F/N ask: Is there an earlier similar subject to (subject being done in 4 above)? When pc gives it:

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Is there a misunderstood word in that subject? If so clear it, auditor also understands it. Do 5 repeatedly until pc runs out of words. Then do 6 again if necessary. But there should have been an F/H by now.
