ARC BREAK RUDIMENT

NOTE: Do not use the ARC Break Rudiment to try to bring down a high TA. Use 2WC What is your attention on? or C/S 53.

The CDEI Scale as assessed when flying the ARC Break rud is now expanded to

CURIOUS  
DESIRED  
ENFORCED  
INHIBITED  
NO  
REFUSED

The rud would be run like this:

- (1) Do you have an ARC/B. Read suppress or false. Procedure is outlined in Drill TR 3000 - 3&4.
- (2) What was it.
- (3) "Was it a break in ARCU". Assess.
- (4) Was it CDEI No Refused (assess) \_\_\_\_\_ (add ARC or U as assessed in 3).
- (5) Give the pc the combined assessment as ARCU plus CDEINR as "It was \_\_\_\_\_". e.g. "It was a no reality".
- (6) If no F/N, "Is there an earlier similar ARC Break. Handle as in 2, 3, 4 & 5.
- (7) Repeat 2 to 6.
- (8) End Phenomena is F/N, Cognition, VGIs.

Auditor Drills TR 3000 - 1, 2, 3 & 4 remain exactly the same but now ARC Break rud has two additions to the CDEI assessment.

By adding No and Refused the actual by-passed charge can be located and indicated more accurately.

Very rarely the pc will have his own item instead of CDEINR and will volunteer it.
