IT IS VITALLY, VITALLY IMPORTANT THAT ONE GETS ANY PERSON WHO HAS GONE CLEAR THROUGH HIS NEXT REQUIRED STEPS (DCSI, THE SUNSHINE RUNDOWN AND SOLO COURSE PARTS I AND II), ONTO OT I AND THROUGH OT III RAPIDLY.

This means with no unnecessary interruption of that route whatsoever. It means with any additional required auditing or preparation kept to the minimum that <u>is</u> required.

Some C/Ses and auditors have had confusions regarding the No-Interference Area and have not fully aligned the technical developments made in recent years with the basic principle and

rules regarding the No-Interference Area. Some pcs, as a result, have been audited on actions which were not needed or which they should not have been given between Clear and OT III.

Therefore, I am updating and revising this HCOB to state exactly what can and cannot be delivered in the No-Interference Area and in the areas between Clear and OT I and between OT levels after OT III.

C/Ses must hold this line strongly and ensure the No-Interference Area rules are kept totally in so Clears and pre-OTs do not get messed up and delayed from getting through OT III as they should.

This responsibility actually extends further, as it is up to every Scientologist everywhere to see that Clears are made and that they do then move on up through the OT levels.

This works two ways: If it is an overt to audit Clears and OTs on actions they don't need, it is as much an overt to not get the person up through what he does need so he can get onto upper OT levels. In other words, we could get into a situation of Clears parked on the Bridge for years and never getting onto OT levels, with all C/Ses being very careful to not audit them on anything else. But they never get up to OT III either!

MAJOR ADVANCES

Two phenomenal technical advances made in recent years -- NEW ERA DIANETICS and the technology resulting in the NED for OTs Levels -- have, by their nature, made it especially necessary to clarify and re-enforce the No-Interference Zone.

These two powerful developments alone represent giant strides in the refinement of the technology. With their release in 1978 we were suddenly making Clears and OTs more rapidly than ever before.

One result of the research which culminated in NED and the NED for OTs Levels was the discovery that Dianetics must not be run on Clears and Pre-OTs. This required a full review of auditing, training and correction materials to align all of the various levels and actions with that vital technical rule.

With the additional developments which followed upon the heels of these advances --- the Purification Rundown, the Happiness Rundown, the shift in the Grade Chart which puts Grades 0 to IV before NED, the DCSI and Sunshine Rundown, the new Solo Auditor Course Part I which can be done in Orgs, OT Preparation and Solo Auditor Course Part II done at Saint Hills or higher orgs, all of these major advances in themselves --- I made certain that brand new NED Clears moving up the Grade Chart through OT III, the NED for OTs Levels and beyond, would have available the tech they need, both auditing-wise and training-wise, each step of the way.

The route to Clear and OT is now swifter. It needs to be very well-defined and handled standardly, from an administrative as well as a technical viewpoint.

CLARIFICATION OF THE NO-INTERFERENCE AREA

The original statement "From R6EW to OT III one does not do anything except keep the pc winning for R6EW to OT III" was based on data learned the hard way, that you don't do other major auditing actions between these two points.

It applies just as stringently today as when it was first written.

THE NO-INTERFERENCE AREA IS STILL THE NO-INTERFERENCE AREA, WITH EXCLAMATION POINTS:

THE BAND FROM R6EW to OT III!!

For those who have gone Clear on NED this band would be: from OT I to OT III.

The original No-Interference Area is still the most critical band on the Grade Chart.

However:

1. Immediately preceding this zone we now have Clears being made on NED, and the range from Clear to OT I is a critical area in itself.

ANYONE WHO IS CLEAR BUT NOT OT III HAD BETTER BE PUSHED UP TO OT III FAST BECAUSE OTHERWISE HE IS AT RISK.

While there are a few additional actions which can be safely delivered to a person who has gone Clear on NED before he goes onto OT I, my statement in capitals above emphasizes the importance of a standard, uninterrupted route up to OT III for Clears.

Additionally:

2. Immediately following OT III and new OT IV, we have Pre-OT's becoming more OT on New OT V (Audited NOTs) and New OT VII (Solo NOTs).

Because of the nature of the materials handled at those levels, there are certain actions which can and others which cannot be given a pre-OT between his OT III completion and New OT IV, or between New OT IV and New OT V (Audited NOTs) or between OT levels above that.

While these factors do not change the original No-Interference Area, they do give us two additional zones which flank it on either side and which are sensitive areas in themselves. Each has its own guidelines and rule concerning which services are permitted within that range.

Therefore, to handle any uncertainty anyone might have on the subject, what CAN and what CANNOT be delivered at any point within the No-Interference Zone and its two flanking areas has now been laid out very specifically here.

This is vital data that Orgs of all levels must have and duplicate well, as it is up to every unit delivering the tech to ensure that the No-Interference Area is correctly enforced.

TECHNICAL RULES

The charts that are given below have been worked out based mainly on the following technical rules:

1. WHEN C/SING A RUNDOWN ONE C/SES THAT RUNDOWN, NOT A MIXTURE OF DIFFERENT RUNDOWNS. EACH RUNDOWN IS ITSELF AND NO OTHER, AND EACH RUNDOWN HAS ITS OWN REPAIR. (Ref: HCOB 28 Sep 82, C/S Series 115, MIXING RUNDOWNS AND REPAIRS.)

This applies to any Grade, OT Level or Rundown.

2. ANY PERSON IN PROGRESS ON A TR COURSE OR IN PROGRESS ON A TR CYCLE MAY NOT ALSO BE AUDITED.

PERSONS IN PROGRESS ON OT III, AUDITED NOTS OR SOLO NOTS MAY NOT DO TR COURSES. (Ref: HCOB 26 May 71R, C/S Series 38R, TRS COURSE AND AUDITING, MIXING MAJOR ACTIONS.)

3. IT IS FORBIDDEN TO RUN DIANETICS ON A CLEAR OR OT. (Ref: HCOB 12 Sep 78, DIANETICS FORBIDDEN ON CLEARS AND OTS.)

CLEARS AND OTS MAY BE GIVEN TOUCH ASSISTS AND CONTACT ASSISTS, BUT NO DIANETICS OR DIANETIC ASSISTS.

C/S APPROVAL REQUIRED

Before any of the actions listed below that may be delivered to Clears and OTs are delivered, C/S approval is required from a Case Supervisor qualified to C/S for that Clear or OT Level.

THE NO-INTERFERENCE CHART

I. BETWEEN CLEAR AND OT I, FOR PERSONS WHO WENT CLEAR ON NED:

A. CAN BE GIVEN:

Auditing/Solo Training:

DCSI and the Sunshine Rundown
Solo Auditor Course Part I
OT Preparations/Solo Set Ups
Solo Auditor Course Part Two

Eligibility For OT Levels Check
PTS Handling, if required, but no Dianetics.

A Confessional, if required, per HCOB 8 Mar 82R, CONFESSIONALS AND THE NON-INTERFERENCE ZONE, but not during the DCSI or Sunshine RD.

End of Endless Int RD, only if required.
(Note: This is a major rundown, not a repair action.)

Training, Word Clearing, Correction:

Any training (including Academy Levels 0-4 up to Class VIII, but not the Key to Life Course).

Professional TR Course

Word Clearing M2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and Crashing MU Finding.

Study Correction Lists, with special instructions followed for handling Clears.

False Data Stripping, Post Purpose Clearing, Long or Short Form Product Clearing, Product Debug steps which do not include case handling, Primary RD (the Primary RD can be done providing Method One was already done prior to going Clear).

Any of the above listed training/correction actions may be delivered at any org or unit qualified to deliver the service but, with the exception of word clearing, only after the DCSI and Sunshine RD.

If, during any training or correction action, the person runs into any case difficulty or bog that cannot be handled easily by the org where he is training, he must be routed at once to an SH or higher org to get it resolved.

C. EXCEPTION:

SHs, AOs and the FSO can deliver certain rundowns and other actions as part of OT Preps (including repair of past auditing, etc.). These are exactly as given in materials on OT Preps and Solo Set Ups.

ROUTING OF CLEARS

Orgs (and Missions) may not hold onto Clears unnecessarily. The responsibility is to prepare each pc properly by delivering the lower Grade Chart actions very standardly in correct sequence for the individual. Then, when he has gone Clear on NED, the route is DCSI, Sunshine RD, Solo Auditor Course Part I, and from there on to a Saint Hill or higher org to continue right on up the Bridge.

Any person who goes Clear in a Mission must be immediately routed to an Org, so that he gets right on up the Bridge.

All Orgs and Missions, all C/Ses, auditors and other tech personnel are responsible for ensuring that the Bridge flow lines are kept smooth and do not get jammed or snarled up at any particular point.

II. FROM R6EW TO OT III (OR FOR THOSE PERSONS WHO WENT CLEAR ON NED, FROM OT I TO OT III):

A. CAN BE GIVEN:

Auditing:

R6EW and the Clearing Course (Alternate route, only for those who did not go Clear on NED.)

OT I, OT II, OT III

Repair Lists (only those repair lists designated for the Solo level the person is on.)

PTS A Handling, if required, including a PTS CS-1.

A Confessional, only if needed. (Per HCOB 8 Mar 82R, CONFESSIONALS AND THE NON-INTERFERENCE ZONE.)

Training, Word Clearing, Correction:

Any training course, with the exception of the Key To Life Course, and no TRs.

Word Clearing on the materials the person is using, but only of a type that doesn't take the person backtrack. (Thus Method One may not be done.)

Crashing MU Finding, Post Purpose Clearing, Long or Short Form Product Clearing, Product Debug steps which do not involve case actions on the "Cannot Be Given" list below. Can also be crammed using starrate checkouts, word clearing and debug actions specified above.

TRS

Never order TRs after Solo Materials study or before OT III is attested.

TRs should be done before or during Solo Auditing study but not after materials are issued. And the TR Course may not be done from then on to OT III.

A partially completed earlier TR Course found to be hanging up a pc on Solo Grades can be handled to completion and should be. This does not mean long additional hours of TR O. It usually means word clearing on the TR materials and rehab.

Similarly, if auditors or others in this band need to be crammed on TRs they could, with C/S okay, be checked out, word cleared and rehabbed on TR materials, but extensive TR drilling may not be done. In adjudicating on this or other permitted corrective actions, the main C/S references are HCOB 26 May 71R, C/S Series 38R, TRS COURSE AND AUDITING, MIXING MAJOR ACTIONS and HCOB 28 Sep 82, C/S Series 115, MIXING MAJOR RUNDOWNS & REPAIRS. For a C/S using these in handling cases in the No-Interference Area there is the added factor that he is dealing with the most critical band of the Grade Chart.

MAJOR ACTIONS

It is a very losing game to throw a major rundown in between Clear (or R6EW) and OT III. The result is a mess.

The way to recover such a blunder is to get the pc rehabbed or to a rest point on the rundown and then finish up the Solo Grades to OT III attest and then complete the rundown.

SPECIAL NOTE

The data above under List II for the No-Interference Area applies as well to those in progress on any OT Level above OT III. (Ref: HCOB 28 Sep 82, C/S Series 115, MIXING RUNDOWNS & REPAIRS.)

III. THOSE PERSONS COMPLETED ON OT III AND/OR COMPLETED ON ANY LEVEL ABOVE OT III:

A. CAN BE GIVEN, BETWEEN ANY OT LEVELS ABOVE OT III:

Auditing:

Purification Rundown

Happiness Rundown

A Confessional, if needed.

Any required PTS Handling that does not use Dianetics.

Prepared Lists, as applicable, with special instructions followed for handlings on Clears and OTs.

L10, L11, L12

Cause Rehabilitation Rundown

Training, Word Clearing, Correction:

Any training course

Professional TR Course

Key To Life Course

Method One Word Clearing

Crashing MU Finding, False Data Stripping, Long or Short Form Product Clearing, Post Purpose Clearing, Product Debug steps which do not involve case actions, Data Series #25 and/or Hubbard Consultant Outpoint-Pluspoint List, Primary RD, Primary Correction RD.

NOTE: The services listed above which may be given between one completed OT Level above OT III and the next must only be given by persons qualified to audit, C/S or supervise these actions and who (if the service calls for any case handling type of action) are of the same or higher case level. In doing any of these actions at a lower org, should the pre-OT get into any difficulty which cannot be easily handled locally, he must be sent to an AO or the FSO for handling.

B. CANNOT BE GIVEN, BETWEEN OT LEVELS OR OTHERWISE:

Auditing:

Scientology Drug Rundown

NED Drug Rundown

NED or any Dianetic Auditing

Dianetic Assists

ARC Straightwire

Grade O Processing

Grade I Processing

Grade II Processing

Grade III Processing

Grade IV Processing

Power Processing Grade V Power Processing Grade VA R6EW The Clearing Course, etc.

C. EXCEPTION:

In the instance of someone who did not make lower levels before OT I yet started on the OT levels anyway (called a "by-passed case" per confidential AO materials), the person, after OT III, could be put back to complete some lower action that he did not honestly attain. This would only be done at an AO and C/Sed only by a fully qualified AO C/S, and no R3R or Power Processing could be run.

SET UP

It is VERY important that a pc be fully prepared with Purification RD, Objectives and other needed drug handling steps, lower Grades and any other needed lower Grade Chart actions, before he goes onto NED and goes Clear. It is highly recommended that a pc get his Method One Word Clearing before starting NED.

And it is VERY important that the pc be set up standardly with OT Preparations, Solo Set Ups, completion of the Solo Auditor's Course Part II and the Eligibility for OT Levels Check at an SII or higher Org before going onto OT I.

AUDITING SKILL

None of this states that you can't improve a pc's auditing skill between Clear and OT III (excepting TRs).

BIG wins are to be had by doing so.

THE MAJOR CAUSE OF FAILURE ON SOLO GRADES IS THE INABILITY TO AUDIT.

Therefore, it is also VERY important that the person be trained standardly on the Solo Auditor Course, Parts I and II, as these have been designed to train him up to be a superb Solo Auditor.

It is also highly recommended that one train up to Class IV and NED auditor levels. (Ref: HCOB 27 Dec 82, TRAINING AND OT.)

The sources of failure on Solo are:

- 1. Incomplete drug handling.
- 2. Incomplete NED. (Did not go Clear on NED but was incorrectly declared Clear when he hadn't made it.)
- 3. Case not set up.
- 4. Inability to audit.

SUMMARY

Realize that from Clear on NED through OT III and for those in progress on New OT IV (OT Drug RD), New OT V (Audited NOTs) or in progress on a higher OT level, you have a closed band for other major actions. The only exceptions are those few given on the lists herein. And in the future, as new technical breakthroughs are made and new auditing rundowns are released, these lists will be updated to show at which points such RDs can and cannot be safely delivered.

Don't let people onto the solo levels who have points 1 - 4 listed above out.

If it has happened, patch it up as you can and let the pre-OT get on with it.

Due to the tremendous number of technical advances which have been made in the past decade, and the nature of these advances, maintaining the No-Interference Area rules to ensure that pcs move rapidly up the Bridge becomes the responsibility of every Org, every Mission, every Unit and every individual Scientologist on this planet.

It is not only a responsibility.

It is a trust.
