PREPCHECK

URGENT DATA

The Prepcheck as a process has not been made full use of for many years.

The 18 buttons when first written up as such by LRH in the early 60's are points of DECISIONS by the thetan.

The Axioms very clearly explain why such points are of paramount importance, being as they are, senior to Mest, and capable of bringing about change.

The Phoenix lectures outline how primary postulates get alterised and how then an accumulation of mass ensues.

Merely running one button to F/N does not clear the particular subject if it was really reading.

The definition of a "good real read" for the purpose of prepcheck is not sF (small Fall), but anything from a Fall on up (F, LF, FsBD, FBD, LFBD).

A datum once crept in (Not LRH datum) that if one ran into an ARC break and cleaned that up, that that would be the end of the prepcheck.

This is incorrect and cancelled.

LRH RULE: THERE ARE 18 BUTTONS & F/N'S FOR EACH ITEM.

LRH RULE: CARRY THE BEST READING ITEMS TO THE WHOLE ARRAY OF BUTTONS.

ONLY DO THIS TO GOOD REAL READS, NOT SF.

CARRY ON DOWN THROUGH THE BUTTONS, F/N FOR EACH.

The prerequisites for the prepcheck is an assessment of items that have to do with that specific case.

Example of such a list for assessment (as taken from a pc's interview or worksheet as items that blew down or read): Mother, Father, Post, Job, Money, Travel, Horses,.

One assesses it as a list, only uses distinct falls or BDs as the item or items to be prepchecked.

An excellent TR1, which impinges and causes correct reads.

An auditor who knows instant reads.

The rule of only handling one button applies only to an item which reads sF or less, provided the skill of the auditor in TR1 and meter reading is as outlined above.

Bad TR's or Out Code stifle reads, as basically one already works over an ARC break when these facts are present.

The prepcheck correctly done is a real winner.
