THE L3B RUNDOWN

DIANETIC TRACK REPAIR

(REF: 3 December, 1971 "Expanded GF-40RR, Handling sheet for Listing and R3R Items", and HCOB 9 December, 1971 "PTS Rundown, Cases")

This is a rundown Ron developed and tested on Flag. It is the first step done before a PTS Rundown is done.

It goes sometimes for <u>sessions</u>. It is a major action. I've given it out already and had it brushed off.

The pc's body is trouble because of unflat engram chains. The pc's engrams don't erase <u>BECAUSE THE EARLY ONES' WEREN'T ERASED</u>. LATER ERASURES ARE HELD DOWN BY THE EARLIEST ONES RUN NOT HAVING BEEN ERASED.

The C/S for the rundown would be:

- 1. 2WC or fly a rud to F/N.
- 2. R-Factor We are looking for engrams contacted in early auditing and not fully handled.
- 3. Assess L3B, 1 to 80 method five with the preface "In your early Dianetics _____?"
- 4. Handle the items in sequence of read size; some examples of handling of specific items as given by LRH would be:
 - (a) (4 of L3B) "In running early engrams what item run described just one incident?" Spot it, date to blow, locate to blow.
 - (b) (6 of L3B) "What early incidents were stirred up and not erased?" Spot earliest, do L3B on it. Erase it.
 - (c) (8 of L3B) "When running one item, it appears you ran into another and ran a different set of pictures?" Date to blow, locate to blow.
 - (d) (16 of L3B) "In early engrams what was the incorrect date?" Correct it, or redate to blow, locate to blow.
 - (e) (17 of L3B) "In early engrams, what was the incorrect duration?" Correct it, date to blow, locate to blow.

The object of the rundown is to handle what comes up on the L3B, not 2WC to FN on the reads and indicate BPC. Take each item found to EP. If obvious auditor goofs, (by read and pc indication), do an L1C Method 3 on what came up. You can also

do a new L3B on the item if no resolution occurs. HANDLE FACH READ WITH COMPLETING THE ACTION OR L3B UNTIL THE ONES THAT DIDN'T ERASE THEN DO ERASE.

The L3B general on early engrams is taken over and over again Method Five to a fully FNing list and a pc who's engrams do erase. THE EP IS THE TRACK BLOWS CLEAN. THE LIST OF COURSE MUST BE WORD CLEARED ON ALL LIST WORDS AND R3R PROCEDURE BEFORE DOING THE RUNDOWN. A great many people can't go into Dianetics at all, can't run an engram, that is uniformly one of two things; it is drugs, or the commands have not been cleared. If it was drugs, the drug rundown would be done before the L3B rundown. Well Cleared.

The L3B rundown is a major action, and should be treated as such.
