This can be rectified by PUTTING IN THE RUDS FOR THE PERIOD COVERED (as for example: "In your last session did you...etc...Rud..?"), and uses the discovery that later on track one can put in the ruds on an earlier period.

Although Ron communicated this discovery to the Class VIII students, it is of sufficient importance to be used by all Scientology auditors.
