

HCO POLICY LETTER OF MARCH 23, 1963

URGENT  
STAR RATING ON R3 CHECK SHEETS  
CLEAR TEST 1963  
ISSUE II

(Cancels HCO Policy Letter of February 22, 1963  
Effective for Every GPM Run.  
To be given by HCO Secs).

No clear is official without this test.

No GPM may be called cleared until this test has been made.

(1) Compare goal with line plot to see that it is the goal of that GPM. (Items low on term column and high on opterm column look like goal). If not, send pc back to have the goal of the line plot found.

(2) Check goal. If it reads in any way, the test is flunked. Use only left hand buttons on the goal in the test. Send case back to have by-passed RIs found.

(3) Compare the pc's line plot to the line plot given in HCO Bulletin of March 13, 1963, or subsequent issues of line plots in HCO Bulletins. If the line plot does not compare in all respects, particularly the lower end, send pc back to have by-passed RIs found and plot completed.

(4) Read over each RI given on plot to see if any read in any way. If any read in any way send pc back to have by-passed RIs found.

(5) Meter on pc the question "Has the auditor told you to put certain items on your lists?" "Has this line plot been found by auditing?" If either react clear the question on the pc and take appropriate action for false reports.

Ignore the goal and two RIs found into next GPM.

Ignore any comments by pc about mass or somatics or gains.

Ignore absence of free needle. It may have been engulfed by next GPM.

Ignore incorrect TA position unless very high or very low (4.5 or 1.8). It may have been affected by next GPM.

This same test is given for every GPM run.
