BOARDS OF INVESTIGATION (Adds to HCO Pol. Ltr. of 4 June 1966)

A Board of Investigation may (and should) be convened any time there is an unusual improvement in an org or its statistics.

Such a Board must (a) isolate the reasons or changes which brought about the improvement; (b) draw up their findings in the form of policy or directives to pass them on to the convening authority; and (c) recommend commending any person found responsible for the improvement (the Board doés not commend, it only recommends, the convening authority alone may issue the commendation).

FORM OF FINDINGS

All findings of a Board of Investigation must be phrased in terms that may be issued without change by a convening authority as a directive or, by the proper additional lines, policy.

The convening authority may after this wording but it must be written so that it does not need to be re-written.
