In HGC of in Review the Green Form is done on the order of the Case Supervisor. A Green Form read is handled when it occurs. Handling doesn't mean calling the item until suppressed. The new Auditors Code is observed on every line. If the line reads and the PC of Pre OT protests it, has no answers, seems ARC Broken by the read or resigned or starts to explain how the thing has been run before, check for false read. Use False and Suppress as per HCO Bulletin 18 Nov. 68.

All significant TA is noted on the line which it occured with PC's statement also note F/N with indicators. The Green Form is ended on a F/N with good indicators, no GIs check ARC Break and clean. A PC or Pre OT who has had a lot of lists done on him or her or a lower level student or the ARC Break Auditor handle by itsa earlier similar itsa.

On Environment ARC Break the proper action is Remedy B - Environment, HCOB 14 Aug. 68 - this is a limited process. S & D is also a limited process, only one F/N available on W, one F/N on S, one F/N on U.

Do not audit a PC or Pre OTwho has not had sufficient food or rest or who has taken aspirin or drugs, check this before session. If he or she has had insufficient food or rest, send the PC home to have this handled. Indicate the by-passed charge of the incomplete cycle of Action of the Session on both Questions 2 and 3.

The Green Form should be run to F/N or to completion and not ended off beforehand unless the Suditor has gotten the PC into something he cannot handle.
