OFFENSES AND PENALTIES ADDITION

Added to Misdemeanors as contained in HCO Policy Letter 7 March 1965 Offenses and Penalties are the following:

Invoicing and/or depositing cheques obtained in confidence,

Giving Org Services on the basis of confidence cheques received without having had the confidence cheque made good and correctly invoiced and banked first.

Definition of "Confidence cheque" - a cheque known by the person accepting it as NOT valid and covered by funds at time of acceptance, but accepted nevertheless on basis of promise by the drawer to make it good at a later date.

Penalties for Misdemeanors apply.
