STUDY POINTS FOR THE HQS COURSE

The following is the point system for the HQS Course.

<u>STUDY ACTION</u>	<u>POINTS</u>
1. Any written material.	1 point per page
2. Clay demonstrations (only credited if done precisely as per HCO B 11 Oct '67 "Clay Table Training").	25
3. OT TR O	40 per hour plus 100 for passing.
4. TR O Confronting to a pass	40 per hour plus 100 for passing.
5. TR O Bullbait to a pass	40 per hour plus 100 for passing.
6. Other TRs or Drills	50 each
7. Practical items	20 each
8. Student Auditing Requirements	
Flunked session	0
Not Flunked session	35 per auditing hour
Well Done session	60 per auditing hour
Very Well Done session	80 per auditing hour

The point system is the standard point system and is to be used on the HQS Course. It cancels all previous systems.

A point system is used so that students may accurately measure their progress through a course. It further provides a quantitative measurement of the production of the course.

The system itself is based on (1) how long a particular study action takes and (2) the type of action it is. Thus the practical is more heavily weighted than the theory, since the purpose of study is application.

ALL POINTS MUST BE EARNED.

The point system assumes that the student knows and can apply all the data for which he has gotten points.

At the end of course time each student adds up the points for the period and hands it in to the Course Administrator. These will be graphed on the Students graph kept daily.

At the end of the week when the students fill out their weekly report, total points for the week are filled in on the form by the students.

These points are the students study statistics and are inspected daily by the Supervisor to ensure good progress on Course. He gives statistic targets to students to raise their stats and if a student has a low stat he acts to remedy.

NON EXISTENCE	Less than 300	Less than 1,100

Note: The trend of the stat should be taken into account.
