LANGUAGE TECHNOLOGY

It has been found that the WHY for persons not learning languages fast enough is that THE TECHNOLOGY OF LEARNING LANGUAGES IS NOT KNOWN TO BE A TECHNOLOGY.

Existing language courses are often ineffective as there IS a precise technology, which is not known as it has been lost.

You Chinese School (instructor or supervisor gives word, group repeats it in unison) nouns, only nouns, and study only child's picture books in that language and get a native person to pronounce. Then the verbs are added, then articles then grammar.

Way up the Line = A rapid language.

Another system is that of RECOGNITION. This requires a slide projector. The picture describing a word is flashed on the screen and students are required to give the word. The gradient is progressively increased (nouns, verbs, articles, phrases and sentences). The flash is reduced in time from half a minute down to 1/125th of a second.

Application of this technology to a language course will result in rapid learning of the language, providing "What is a Course?" P/L is kept in.
