MASTER CHECKLIST OF HCO LETTERS

PURPOSE: To have a useful reference of what HCO Admin Ltrs, HCO Advice Letters, HCO Info Ltrs, HCO Exec Ltrs, HCO Newsletters, HCO Technical Ltrs, and HCO Technical Advice Letters have been issued by L. Ron Hubbard, or for him, and when. Also to be able to establish which ones of these aren't on hand, and so get them available for use.

REALITY FACTOR: Each type of issue is listed by itself in date order. Where an issue has "no title" the first few words of the first line in the issue were taken as its title.

For convenience sake, it was decided that all the above types of issues should be in one master checklist, rather than in several separate master checklists.

HCO Admin Letters are the only issue presently being issued at this time. It's doubtful that the HCO Newsletters, HCO Tech Letters and the HCO Tech Advice Letters will be used in the future to relay information.

Of the types of issue, one is a direct line used by LRH to staff, or the public, and that is, HCO Information Letters, which were written entirely by him. Also he has written a great majority of the HCO Executive Letters and some of the HCO Admin Letters.

It should be noted that the LRH Issues carry much valuable information on Scientology and its growth, some of it quite useful to hats and hatting.

HISTORY: The compilation of each type of issue into lists began in December 1971. Through the help of Anne Grieg, LRH Personal Librarian the lists were checked for accuracy and completeness.
