LRH EDs

According to existing policy, LRH EDs like all EDs expire one year after issue.

This policy presupposes that the ED in the course of that year actually got COMPLETED.

An LRH ED expires only when:

- (a) It is fully complied with, and the verified compliance has been accepted through LRH Comm Aide Flag and CS-7 by LRH, AND
- (b) One year from date of issue has elapsed, OR
- (c) The LRH ED is amended or cancelled by another LRH ED.

If at the end of a year after issue the LRH ED is STILL not complied with, Ethics action can be expected on the failing LRH Comm and local executives, at the instigation of LRH Comm Aide, Flag or CS-7.

END OF CYCLE

Henceforward, LRH Comm Aide Flag or CS-7 will issue an addition to each LRH ED one year after date of original issue.

The addition will state clearly which orgs and units can consider the ED expired, and which orgs must continue to work on it.

The aim will be to have the ED completed and expired for ALL orgs and units it applies to.

RE-LOGGING

The LRH Comm of any org has the power to re-log any LRH issue for compliance anew.

This includes LRH EDs which have expired or are over one year old.

This right is fully retained.

However, the force of LRH Comm's order to re-do an LRH item is provisional on:

- (a) sending via Cont LRH Comm and LRH Comm Aide Flag to CS-7 the evaluation on which the re-log is based, retaining a copy for inspection in the org;

- (b) receiving confirmation from LRH Comm Aide Flag or CS-7 that the re-log is justified, correct, and co-ordinated with all other Flag Management Staff actions concerning the org.

This exchange is NOT put on telex lines automatically. A Flag cancellation might be telexed, if urgent.

DISPUTED RE-LOGGING

If a local Exec feels that the re-logging is an incorrect action and will be damaging to stats, he may inspect the LRH Comm's Eval on the re-logging, and then can:

1. WCM4 the issue to be re-logged
2. WCM4 the LRH Comm Eval
3. Submit a Query of Orders per PL 15 Dec 69 "Orders Query of" to the LRH Comm who must handle it at once.

If stats are shown to have gone down later, investigation must be done at once to establish if the re-logging was the real Why. If so, it must be cancelled and reverted and fully reported via LRH Comm Aide for Flag Data Files.

The CO or ED may originate or okay a telex from the executive disputing the re-logging, after No. 3 above, to the FOLO and Management Rep for his org, and LRH Comm Aide, Flag if the LRH Comm upholds his decision to re-log and it is still held as incorrect.

With proper co-ordination of Org Pgms at Flag with LRH Comm lines, and Correct use of Data Series 23-25, no undue trouble should occur.

Both unjustified protests on re-loggings and incorrect re-loggings which do damage stats are subject to Ethics handling.

A re-log can apply to a whole Org, a section or more, or to an individual.

Any LRH issue may be re-logged (that hasn't already been cancelled or amended legally).
