> PUBLIC IMAGE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ENFORCEMENT (ENFORCEMENT POWERS) (Reference HCO PL 1 March 66 and HCO PL 7 March 65)

Any repeated acts which in any way destroy or reduce the religious status of any Scientology Organization or Minister or the <u>bona fides</u> of Scientology as a religion shall be considered Suppressive Acts — worsening public relations.

The Office of the Guardian Continental is granted and holds summary ethics powers as regards compliance with the religious image guidelines as applied to all Churches, Missions and Field Auditors. The only recourse is the right to petition.

The Deputy Guardian Continental may from time to time authorize a Guardian Office Inspection Mission to any Church or Mission to ensure compliance with religious image policies.

The Deputy Guardian may also recommend to the Board withdrawal of invitation to Advanced Courses for flagrant violations of policy which put any Church, Minister or Mission in legal jeopardy.
