BUILDING HCO

AN HCO THAT BUILDS ITSELF CAN BUILD AN ORG.

The following is the cycle of building an HCO:

- 1. You take arriving recruits who are not scheduled for specific posts.
- Product Zero them (for S0 orgs only); SS 0 them (for C1 IV orgs only).
- 3. Temporarily post them as HCO Expeditors with actual duties on a post in HCO.
- 4. Actually SS I and SS II them.
- 5. Actually hat checksheet and pack them for the HCO post they will hold.
- 6. Require and hold them to 5 hours study a day.
- 7. Build an HCO without robbing affluence posts or working installations which is the reverse of HCO functions.
