BFL APPEAL LINE

Approval of BPLs and BTBs is obtained through a long routing designed to catch errors in proposed issues.

Even with all this care, an issue can slip through which is later found to be erroneous or even destructive.

If a BPL or BTB on receipt in an org is perceived to be erroneous or potentially destructive, the matter must be drawn to the attention of the FR with CSW.

The FR must verify the CSW, and if found correct must add his own observations on the issue, sending the completed package via his FR command channels to AVU, Flag, for review and correction or cancellation.

The issue is not activated in the org until its correction is received, or until AVU advises that the appeal is rejected.

If the issue is activated and then found to be incorrect, the same procedure is followed.
