HATS, BASIC AND FALSE

What I'm finding as a basic outness in some areas is a false hat, meaning missing correct hat write up. This gives the apparency of "having a hat" to the person and "not wearing a hat" to others.

I am also finding ignorance of the basic hat with know-ledge of all sorts of later odds and ends.

The safest thing to do is:

- 1. Study and grasp the Data Series PLs.
- 2. Study out the Ideal Scene for your post, section, department and Division.
- 3. Work out a stat for post, section, department and Division.
- 4. Work out the Ideal Scene for your org or ship or activity and its stat.
- 5. Work out the Ideal Scene for the whole of Scientology.
- 6. Work out the stat for the whole of Scientology.
- 7. Work out how your post Ideal Scene contributes to the whole of Scientology. If not refine your own Ideal Scene.
- 8. Work out how your stat expresses your own Ideal Scene.

To do this requires a lot of data to be dug up. But when you finish it you really got it.
