KHA-KHAN

(Reference: HCO PL 1 Sept AD15  
Issue VII ETHICS PROTECTION)

The title of "Kha-Khan" signifies a person who is a consistently producing, high statistic staff or crew member or executive. Such people are valuable. A Kha-Khan title is likewise valuable, and should not be taken lightly. Nor should it be awarded lightly.

Executive Director Int and CO CMO Int are the authorities empowered to make such an award.

Should it occur that an executive or MAA or E/O or Committee of Evidence deems it warranted to cancel Kha-Khan status or take away one or more Kha-Khan "lives," that person or body must CSW to the authority mentioned above who awarded the title.

Award the title when it is deserved.

When awarded, accept the title with the pride of ownership it deserves.

When accepted, continue to assume your responsibilities in the manner befitting the honor of the title.

For a Kha-Khan is a leader among leaders.
